



CONTEST RULES



MODALITY FOR ADULTS:

ADULTS OVER 18 YEARS OLD AND YOUTH BETWEEN 14 AND 17 YEARS OLD (MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT WITH AUTHORIZATION; THE FORM WILL BE SIGNED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT).

MODALITY FOR CHILDREN:

CHILDREN BETWEEN 6 AND 13 YEARS OLD. MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT WITH AUTHORIZATION (THE FORM WILL BE SIGNED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT).

ELIGIBILITY:

PARTICIPANTS MUST RESIDE IN THURSTON, MASON, AND LEWIS COUNTIES.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

CONTESTANTS MUST BE PRESENT TO CHECK IN AT THE ENTRANCE AND SIGN THE CONTEST RULES. THEY WILL THEN BE EVALUATED IN A SMALL PARADE IN FRONT OF THE JUDGES.


PRIZES FOR ADULTS:

CONTEST RULES



WHAT WILL BE EVALUATED:

THE JUDGES WILL SCORE THE FOLLOWING ASPECTS FROM 0 TO 5 POINTS:

COSTUME CREATION:

WHETHER THE COSTUMES ARE MADE ENTIRELY OR PARTIALLY BY THE PARTICIPANTS.

ORIGINALITY:

INNOVATIVE DESIGNS. USE OF RECYCLED/ECOLOGICAL MATERIALS.

DETAILS:

PREFERABLY HANDMADE, THOUGH NOT MANDATORY, AND THE COMPLEXITY OF DECORATIONS OR ACCESSORIES.


COSTUMES:

PARTICIPANTS MAY USE MAKEUP AND DRESS AS CATRINA.

JUDGES:

THE PANEL WILL CONSIST OF REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE CIELO COMMITTEES.







REGLAS



- The Catrina costume must be 100% related to Día de Muertos.
- All participants must be respectful to attendees, other participants, staff, and judges. Any disrespect, harassment, gestures, insults, abuse, aggression, explicit sexual behavior, or damage will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant.
- Participation will be individual, without help or support from others, the audience, staff, or support personnel.
- All costumes must be family-appropriate (nudity is not allowed).
- For safety reasons, the following items are not permitted:
 - Animals of any kind.
 - Items that could damage or stain the space or other participants (glitter, confetti, fire, water, aerosol sprays). However, if a participant wants to use hair spray, it must be done before the event.
- All children must be supervised by an adult during their presentation to the judges. There will be no childcare during the event, and CIELO is not responsible for accidents involving unsupervised children.
- The judges' decision will be final and cannot be appealed.
